Prepare For Your First Appointment

ITEMS TO BRING TO YOUR APPOINTMENT:

1. **Photo ID**
2. All **insurance cards**
3. **Co-payment** (we accept cash, debit cards, and credit cards in the form of Visa, MasterCard and Discover. No checks please.)
*Note: If you are unable to provide your co-payment at the time of your visit, we will have to reschedule your appointment.
4. **FILMS or a CD of any imaging.**
 - It is always safer to hand carry your own films to your appointment to ensure they will be here for review. The easiest way to get a copy of your films is to call the radiologist or facility where you had them done and request a copy for you to pick up or be mailed to you.
 - If you are having another office send your records, please call them to ensure that your actual films are being mailed and not just the reports. **FILMS CANNOT BE FAXED.**
 - If you have had a recent MRI or CT and you do not bring the films to your appointment, or they have not arrived from your doctor, we will have to reschedule your appointment.
5. List of **current medications** or your medication bottles.
6. List of any **past surgeries including the treating physician, date and type of surgery**
*If you have had spine surgery, **please bring the operative report** from your previous doctor as well as any records from your treatment.
7. List of **any questions** that you may have for the doctor.



8. **New Patient Paperwork** completed

There are several ways to complete the New Patient Paperwork:

- 2) Go to our website www.triangleneurosurgery.com and click on “Patient Portal” in the upper left corner to register for an account and complete the paperwork online.
